Duration:	Approx. 1 1/2 hours
Number of participants:	Minimum 12, maximum 25 persons
Minimum age:	10 years. School classes and groups of young people must be accompanied by at least two adults.
Dates/Times:	Monday to Friday, times by prior arrangement

How to get here:	Bus no. 160 from Belp railway station in the direction of Bern-Belp Airport to the "Giessenbad" stop. Car & bus parking: a limited number of parking spaces are available. You can find a map and directions on how to get here at: <u>access.rega.ch</u> .
Cost:	Guided tours are free of charge. However, if you cancel your tour less than one week before the booked date, an administration fee of CHF 170.00 plus VAT will be charged.
